

How to Participate:

Once again, registration for the Summer Reading Program and the Book Logs will be done **ONLINE!** Don't worry, it's easy--we provide help. It's also convenient; you can sign-up from any computer with Internet access, from home, school, other public libraries, etc. Here's how to get started...

1. Youngsters entering grades K-8 may participate. High School students may register as teens and use the online reading log to keep track of their books.


2. To join, you may use any computer with Internet access, at home, from school, or in the public library. **REGISTRATION BEGINS on Monday, June 8th.** Simply go to the homepage of the Morrill Memorial Library, www.norwoodlibrary.org and look for the Kids and Teens column. There is a section for registering for the program. Click to select.

3. You must choose a **USERNAME** and a **PASSWORD** for your account. We encourage you to choose something that is very easy to remember as you will need to use this every time you go into your account. (The username and passwords ARE CASE SENSITIVE.) Fill in all of the information, and decide how many books you would like to pledge to read throughout the summer. Remember, you can always go over your goal, but you won't complete the program if you don't reach your goal.

4. Once you are registered, you can use the program to record the books you have read throughout the summer. **You must record your books between June 22nd and August 28th.** You can also read and write reviews of the books that you have read. These reviews can be just for your use, but if you click on the "I Agree" button, you can share your reviews with other online users.

5. The program ends on Friday, August 28th, so you must have all of your books recorded in your log by this deadline.

Have fun, and remember to visit the library weekly to select new books, pick-up weekly activity sheets, coupons, and to enter the drawing for a free book.
